SPRING RIDE-A-TEST SCHOOLING SHOW
SATURDAY MAY 3, 2008**

LOCATION: **Bron Dairy, Granger, WA.** All arenas are fully fenced; green horses are encouraged to attend!

DIRECTIONS: **FROM YAKIMA**, take I-82E to Zillah, exit 54, Division Rd. Turn **RIGHT** onto Yakima Valley Hwy for approx. 3 mi. Turn **LEFT** onto Nelson Rd. and go less than 1 mi. to 640 Nelson Rd. **FROM TRI-CITIES**, take I-82W toward Granger, exit 58, WA-223. Turn **RIGHT** onto Vanbelle Rd, then **LEFT** onto Yakima Valley Hwy for approx. 2 mi. Turn **RIGHT** onto Nelson Rd. There will be 2 dairy farms on the right side of Nelson and a large green barn on the left side with show grounds. Turn in the drive to the barn and go **RIGHT** around the barn, then thru the large gate into the first pasture. **PLEASE BE CAREFUL NOT TO DRIVE OR PARK ON SPRINKLER HEADS!**

RIDE-A-TEST FORMAT: For this show we are following a test format that allows the rider to benefit from the judge's suggestions in order to immediately improve on test performance and scores. It is a good format for green horses and inexperienced test riders, which allows for two trys at each test. If you've ever ridden a test and wished for a Do-Over, this is your opportunity! Here's how it works: Ride your test at your scheduled time, but don't leave the arena. Instead, walk your horse up to the judge's stand and listen to the judge's feedback and suggestions, then immediately re-ride the test to get an improved performance. You may have a couple of trot circles, within the show arena, to organize your horse before trotting down the centerline for the second test. You will be riding the same test twice, back to back, with the benefit of the judge's comments in between. When you read your test later, you will see the scores for the first performance of the test in pencil and the scores for the second performance in pen, so you can compare. The score for the second performance will be the final score that will count towards class placing and end of the year awards.

ENTRY FEE: \$20 per ride, which covers riding your test twice, for the price of one!

TESTS: We will be using these standard tests: 2007 TESTS: INTRO THROUGH FOURTH LEVEL, AND FREESTYLE. PSG 2000; INT. 1 - 2002; INT. 2 – 2001; GRAND PRIX 2003 INT. FREESTYLE – 2002; GRAND PRIX FREESTYLE - 1999

REQUIRED: All riders are required to wear riding boots & an ASTM approved helmet, whether showing or not.

ABOUT TRAINING DEVICES: Training devices (draw reins, martingales, etc.) may only be used in tests ridden hors concours. Scores from hors concours tests are not eligible for year-end awards. Leg wraps and splint boots are allowed in regular tests.
